## Workshops and Meetings

As part of the ProDaC project plan regular workshops have been organized twice a year:

- The **kick-off meeting** [1] took place on October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2006, alongside the 5<sup>th</sup> HUPO World Congress in Long Beach, CA, USA.
- The **1<sup>st</sup> ProDaC workshop** [2] was held on April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2007 in Lyon, France, before the HUPO PSI meeting (Proteomics Standards Initiative of the Human Proteome Organisation; <http://www.psidev.info/>).
- In autumn 2007 the **2<sup>nd</sup> workshop** [3] was organized on October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2007 in Seoul, Korea.
- The consortium members met in 2008 for the **3<sup>rd</sup> workshop** in Toledo, Spain on 22<sup>nd</sup> of April, 2008 [4] and
- for the **4<sup>th</sup> workshop** in Amsterdam, The Netherlands, on 15<sup>th</sup> of August, 2008 [5].
- The **5<sup>th</sup> workshop** took place on March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2009 at the Orthodox Academy of Crete in Kolympari, Crete, Greece [6].

## Publications
